The Bible calls Satan:

"The accuser of our brothers [those who know Jesus as their Savior from sin]..." (Revelation 12:10).

To accuse someone means to say that someone has done something wrong.

If you know Jesus as your Savior, Satan will try to accuse you. He will remind you of your sin and tempt you to think that maybe Jesus is not your Savior. He wants you to believe you are just too bad for Jesus to love and forgive.

He might do this by tempting you to believe one of these lies:

Why do you even read the Bible?

You don't really obey it so what's the point.

Why do you even pray to God?

God doesn't answer your prayers.

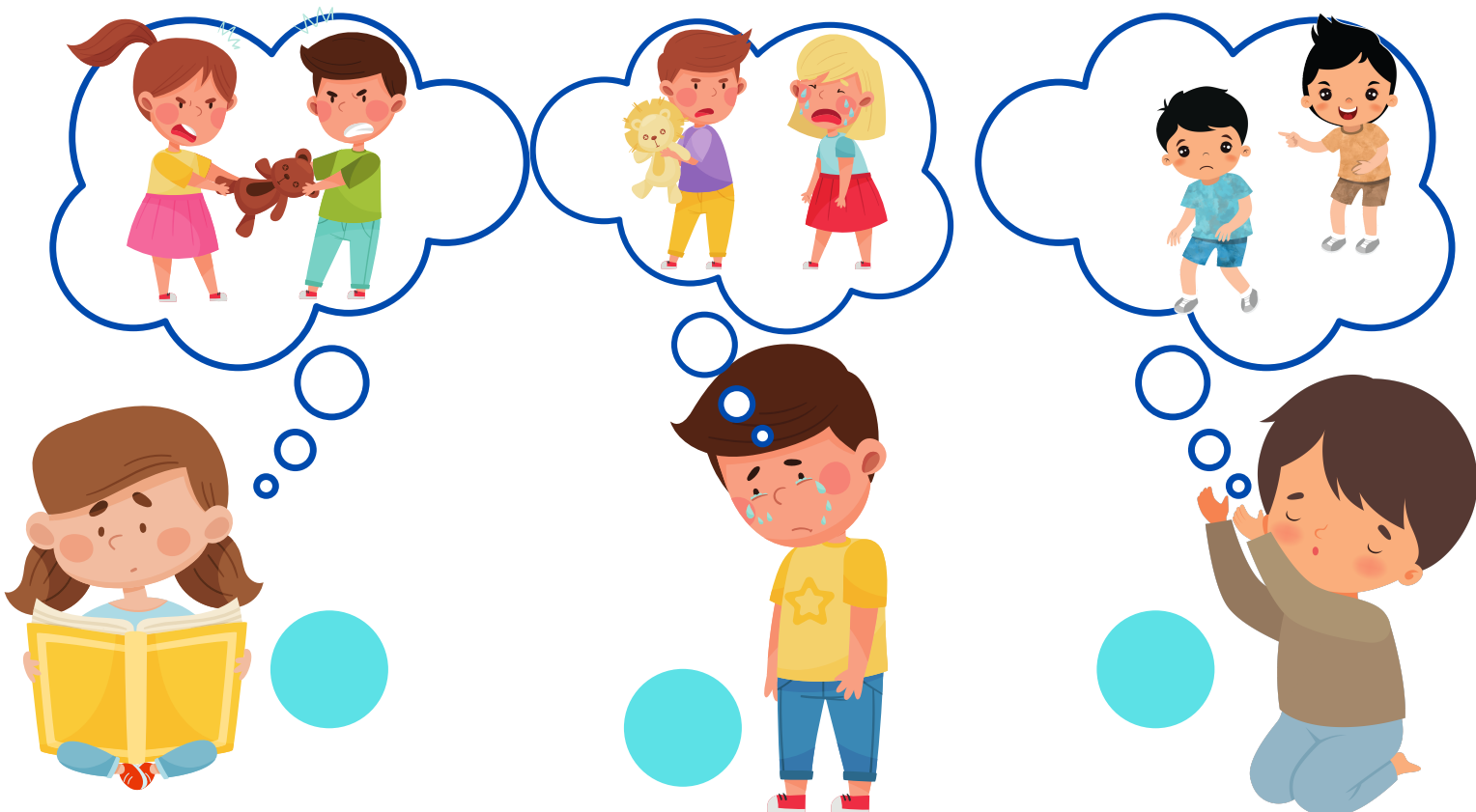
Who do you think you are to pray to God?


DAY - 3

If you know Jesus as your Savior, when Satan accuses you, ask God to help you put on the **Breastplate of Righteousness**! You can do that by remembering you are not made right with God because of the good things you do. You are made right with God because of what Jesus did for you when He died on the cross.

Philippians 3:9 puts it this way:

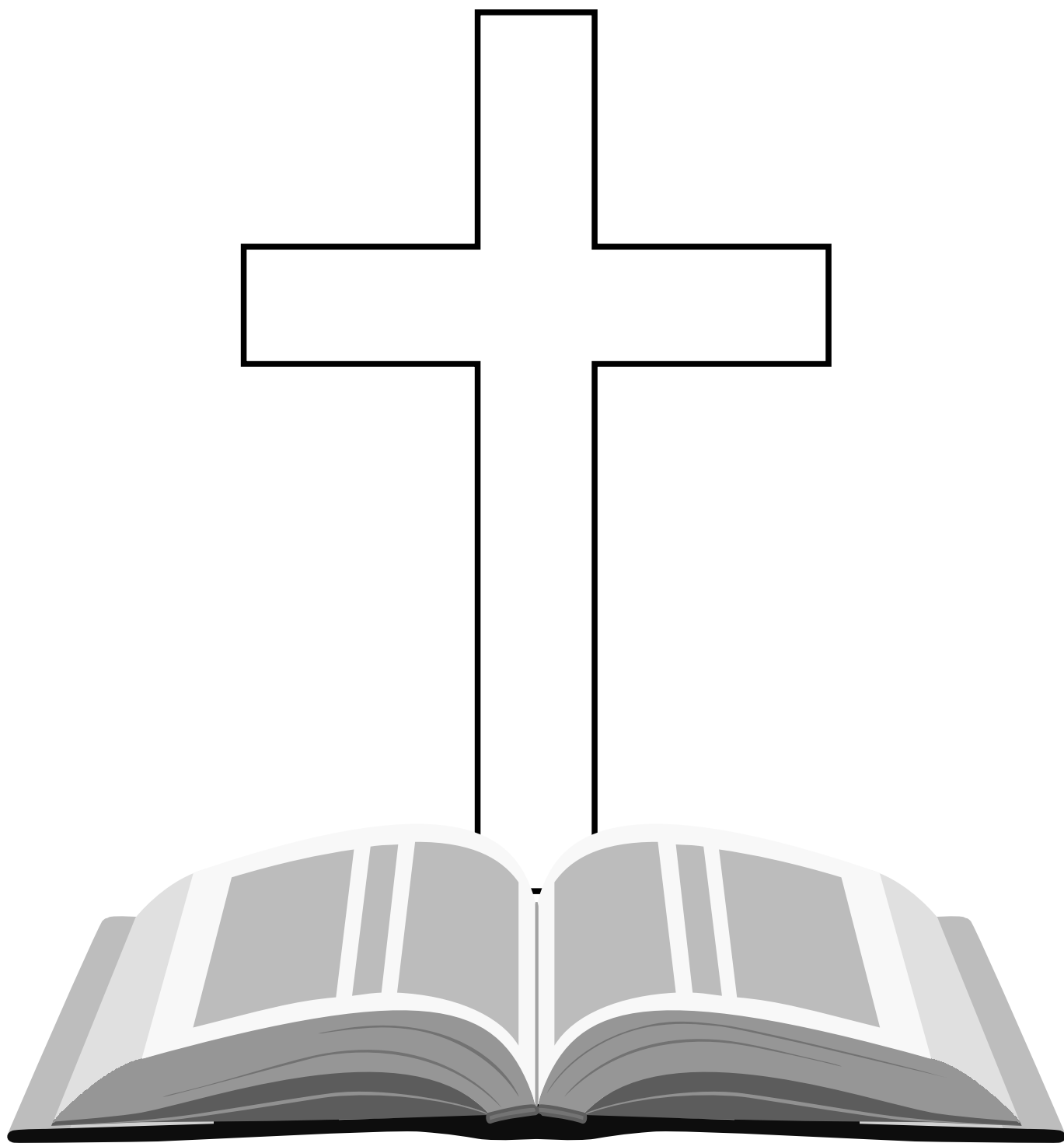
"...And be found in Him [Jesus], not having my own righteousness...but that which is through faith in Christ [because of Jesus and what He did when He died on the cross]..."

If you know Jesus as your Savior, the **Breastplate of Righteousness** should remind you that Jesus loves you and will never leave you.

Color the picture of the cross below. As you color, pray. Thank Jesus for dying on the cross for you so you could be made right with God.

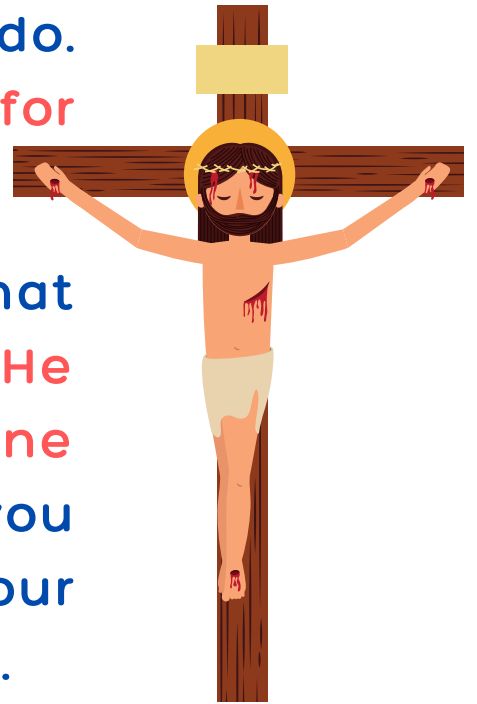


THE ARMOR OF GOD

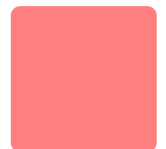
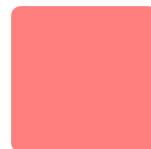
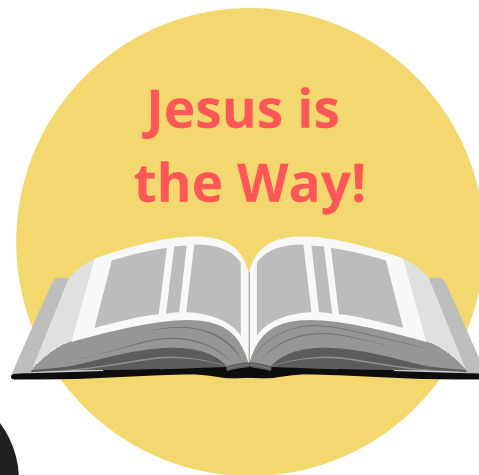
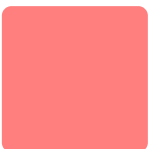
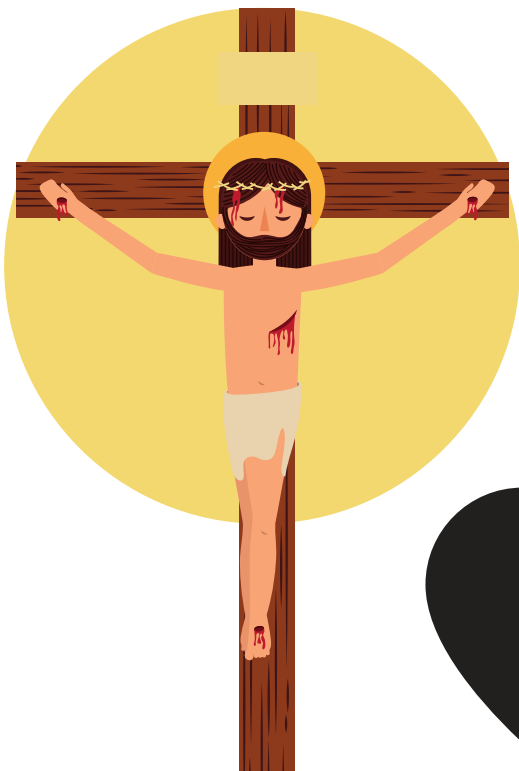
If you do not know Jesus as your Savior, God has a wonderful promise for you. John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." If you believe that Jesus is God the Son and that He is the only One who can save you from your sin, you can tell God something like this. "Dear God, I know that I sin. I believe Jesus died on the cross for me. Please save me." If you believe these things, He will keep His promise, and He will save you!
