LIFE OF CHRIST #2 - "You Can Praise the Saviour Too!"

WEEK OF:

MAIN TRUTH: You should thank God for Jesus.

TO DO AS THE CHILDREN ARRIVE:

- 1. Greet the children; make them feel welcome.
- 2. Take attendance.
- 3. Listen to previous week's memory verse.

PRE-SESSION ACTIVITY:

- 1. OLDER CHILD: "Angels' Message"
- 2. YOUNGER CHILD: Life of Christ #2 Activity Sheet

- 3. You pray today. Ask the children to do the four things mentioned under "We get ready to pray by "

FALL CONTEST EXPLANATION: (4 minutes)

"Feed the Elephants" – You will need two enlarged copies of the elephants; glue each one to a paper bag. Cut out the elephant's mouth so the peanut can go through into the bag. (See attached page.) Mark each bag with the team number or the elephant's name, such as Dumbo and Jumbo. Each week as the children come to Good News Club, they will earn peanuts to feed their team's elephant. (Since many children are allergic to peanuts, you could use paper peanuts. See attached page.) You can decide how many peanuts each member of the team can earn for attending, memorizing the verse, bringing a visitor, completing the Quiet Time Notebook, and answering a review question. In addition, the teacher can give or take away peanuts any time during the club for good behavior, sportsmanship, etc. - by Rita L. Lobdell.

MEMORY VERSE: (7 minutes)

<u>Luke 2:11</u> – "<u>For unto you is born this day</u> in the city of David <u>a Saviour</u>, which is Christ the Lord." (The underlined portion of the verse indicates what the younger children should memorize. See "Involvement Helps for Younger Children" for helps in teaching the verse to the younger children.)

"Motions" – After reading the verse from your Bible, explaining what it means, and repeating it at least two times, you may begin this activity. "For unto you" – Cup hand around mouth as to declare a message; "is born this day" – Hold arms in cradle position; "in the city of David" – Point with arm extended as toward Bethlehem; "a Saviour" – Hold index fingers in form of a cross; "which is Christ the Lord" – Point index finger toward Heaven.

BIBLE LESSON: (20 minutes)

LIFE OF CHRIST #2 - "You Can Praise the Saviour Too!"

COUNSEL TIME:

(If you have a helper, hostess, or Teacher Junior Grade, let them do the review time while you counsel those who responded to the invitation. Otherwise, at the end of club, be sure to remind the children who responded to the invitation to stay after club for a few minutes.)

TAKE TIME TO REVIEW/QUIET TIME NOTEBOOK: (1 minute)

From the returned TTtR/Q.T.N.s, mention one or two of the children's responses to the Main Truth challenge. Hand out Take Time to Review/Quiet Time Notebook, Life of Christ #2. Ask the children to complete the booklet before the next club. Remind them that they need to show you their TTtR/Q.T. Notebook next week.

REVIEW ACTIVITY: (7 minutes)

Use activity below or the Bible Learning Game from "Involvement Helps for Younger Children."

"Scarecrow" – Print the attached pattern on cardstock. Cut out the scarecrows and crows. Prepare a spinner with numbers 1-6 on it. Place a scarecrow and half of the birds on one side of the flannelboard. Place the other scarecrow and the rest of the birds on the other side. Divide your class into two teams. When a child correctly answers a review question, he may spin the arrow. The number the arrow is pointing to indicates how many birds have been scared away from his scarecrow to the other team's scarecrow. Continue in the same manner until the time is up. The team with the least birds wins the game. – By Rita L. Lobdell.

Review questions for LIFE OF CHRIST #2:

- 1. What important event were Mary and Joseph waiting for? (The birth of Jesus)
- 2. Why were Joseph and Mary going to Bethlehem? (To be counted in the census and to pay taxes. It was the city of their ancestors. It was God's plan.)
- 3. Where did Mary and Joseph stay when they arrived in Bethlehem? (In a stable)
- 4. What special thing happened that night in the stable in Bethlehem? (Jesus was born)
- 5. What did they use for Baby Jesus' bed? (A manger, feeding trough for animals)
- 6. Who came to visit the Baby Jesus on the night He was born? (Shepherds)
- 7. How did the shepherds know that Jesus had been born? (An angel appeared and told them)
- 8. What did the shepherds do after they left the stable? (Began telling everyone the good news of Jesus' birth)
- 9. When Jesus grew up, what did He do for you and me and all people? (He died on the cross to pay for our sins and came alive again)
- 10. If Jesus is your Saviour, what should be thank God for every day? (Jesus, the Saviour)





Life of Christ #2 YOU CAN PRAISE THE SAVIOUR TOO!

Luke 2:11

"For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord."

Introduction:

(Show symbols of Facebook, Instagram, Google) Who knows what these stand for? That's right. They remind us of different places we get information. When you want to know what is happening you can open up any of these apps or websites and usually learn all about very important events or announcements. If the internet had been used back in the time when Jesus was on Earth, what do you think would have been all over Google, Facebook, and Instagram the day after His birth? God didn't use the internet or even social media, but an angel, to make an important announcement. This announcement is our memory verse for today.

Presentation:

Read the verse together from the visual. Then read the verse from the Bible.

Explanation:

Luke 2:11 – This is the address of the verse. It's where it's found in the Bible.

"For unto you is born this day" – God used an angel to announce that Jesus, God the Son, was born.

"in the city of David" – The "city of David" is Bethlehem. It's the city where King David came from.

"a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord." – Jesus is the "Saviour". He's the One Who was born on Earth to save us from the punishment of sin.

HELPS FOR YOUNGER CHILDREN

Memory Verse

For younger children, teach only the underlined portion of the verse.

<u>Luke 2:11</u> – "For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord."

Bible Lesson Involvement Helps

Flashcard 1-5:

On count of 3, have children call out at one time how many people are in their family.

Flashcard 2-1:

Have children pack clothing and food in bags for the trip. As Joseph, tie the bundles to the donkey and help Mary to get on.

Pretending to be Joseph, have half the children knock on the inn's door and ask, "Do you have a room for me and my wife?" Pretending to be the innkeeper, have the other children shake their head and reply, "No. I'm sorry, but we're full."

Flashcard 2-2:

Ask, "What kind of animals would stay in a stable? On the count of 3, I want you to make the sound of an animal that you think would be in a stable. 1, 2, 3!" Allow response.

Flashcard 2-3:

Have children very gently wrap Baby Jesus (holding one forearm in front, make circling motions with the opposite hand) and then lay Him in the manger. Look at Him tenderly.

Flashcard 2-4:

Have children stand and repeat the memory verse with you.

Have children joyously repeat, "Glory to God in the highest!"

Acting as shepherds, have children grab their staff and hurry in to town. You may have them stand and walk in place, or you may have them "hurry" the fingers of one hand up the back of the opposite forearm.

Flashcard 2-6:

As shepherds, have children tap their neighbor's shoulder and tell them, "The Saviour was born tonight!"

Bible Learning Game (Going to Bethlehem)

In one area of the room, mark off "Bethlehem" with chairs, masking tape, or a rope lying on the floor. At the command "Walk," the children walk anywhere in the room except in "Bethlehem." When you call "Bethlehem," all the children try to get into the marked off area.

Then say, "Bethlehem was very crowded. Many had to go there to pay their taxes."

Play again using other commands such as: "Take Giant Steps," or "Hop," or "Take Baby Steps," or "Crawl."

- 7. Baby sit. (Children who are too young to baby sit can entertain younger boys and girls while mothers are busy working.)
- 8. Address Christmas cards.
- 9. Clean and cut carrots and celery sticks.
- 10. Wrap Christmas presents.
- 11. Plant sit.
- 12. Polish shoes or boots.
- 13. Clean a garage.
- 14. Collect and return recyclable cans.
- 15. Shovel snow off walks and decks.
- 16. Fold laundry.
- 17. Take the neighbor's mail and newspapers in while they are away.
- 18. Water lawns.
- 19. Make and sell cookies.
- 20. Tutor a younger child in your family or in the neighborhood.
- 21. Run errands for an older person.


