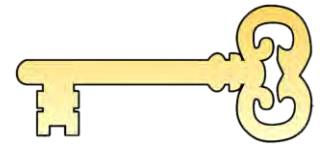

## Matthew 1:16

“And Jacob begat **Joseph** the husband of **Mary**, of whom was born Jesus Who is called **Christ**.”

# Matthew 13:55

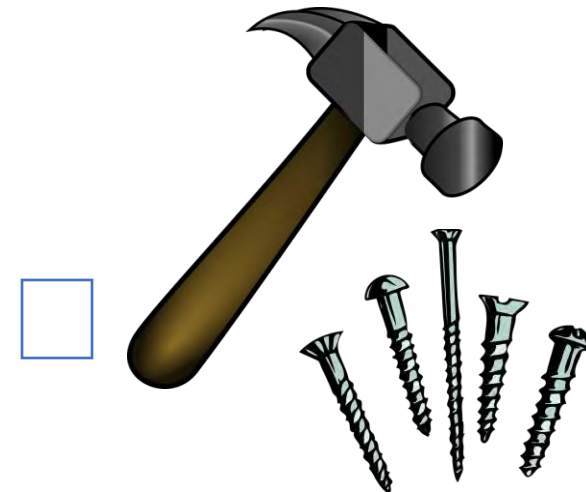
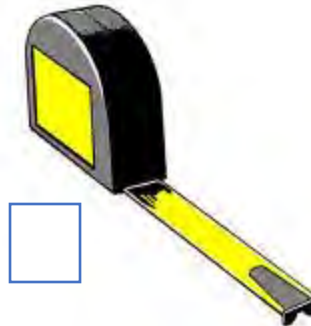
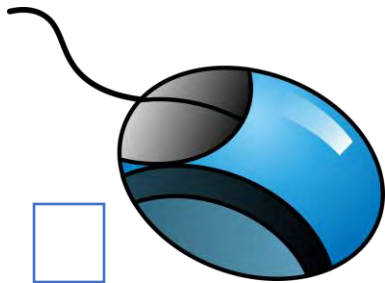
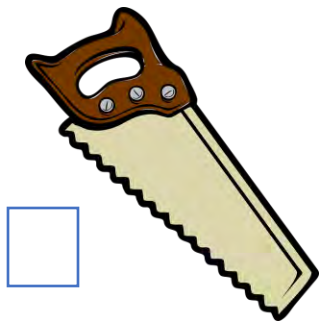
“Is this not the carpenter’s son?

This verse tells us what Mary’s husband, Joseph (Jesus’ step-father), did for a living. He was a **CARPENTER**.

### Matthew 13:55

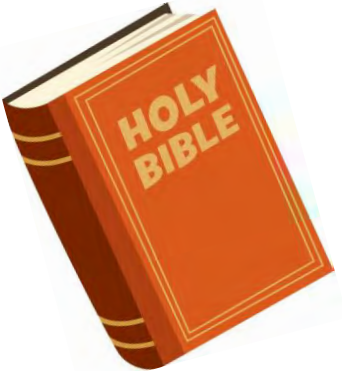
