JOSEPH #4 – "Joseph, Rewarded"

WEEK OF:

MAIN TRUTH: God is in control of all things

TO DO AS THE CHILDREN ARRIVE:

- 1. Greet the children; make them feel welcome.
- 2. Take attendance.
- 3. Listen to previous week's memory verse.
- 4. Have children put money in missions bank.
- 5. Have children put acorns in their team's storehouse according to the number of points earned.

PRE-SESSION ACTIVITY:

SONG: (2 minutes)

PRAYER: (4 minutes)

- 1. Prayer song:
- 2. Review the WHEN WE PRAY IN CLUB and PATTERN FOR PRAYER Charts. Explain the Two Kinds of Prayer "Thank You Prayers" and "Please Prayers." (See attached visual.)
- 3. Let the children mention two things they want to thank God for ("Thank You Prayers") and two things they want to ask God for ("Please Prayers").
- 4. Lead the children in "Thank You Prayers" and "Please Prayers."

MEMORY VERSE: (8 minutes)

<u>Colossians 3:24</u> – "Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward ... <u>for ye serve</u> <u>the Lord Christ</u>."

(The underlined portion of the verse indicates what the younger children should memorize. See *Involvement Helps for Younger Children* for helps in teaching the verse to the younger children.)

"Crazy Stand-Ups" – After you have read this verse from the Bible, explained what it means, and repeated it at least two times, you may begin this drill. Have all the children wearing red stand and repeat the verse; all the children who ride the bus to school stand and repeat the verse; those who have a pet; those who like chocolate ice cream; those who have one brother or sister; those who have brown eyes; etc.

BIBLE LESSON: (20 minutes)

JOSEPH #4 – "Joseph, Rewarded"

(See *Involvement Helps for Younger Children* for ways to involve the children in the Bible Lesson.)

COUNSEL TIME:

(If you have a helper, hostess, or Teacher Junior Grade, let them do the review time while you counsel those who responded to the invitation. Otherwise, at the end of club, be sure to remind the children who responded to the invitation to stay after club for a few minutes.)

<u>E.O.T.O.:</u> (2 minutes)

Demonstrate to the children how to use the E.O.T.O., "Three Steps Out of Slavery." Encourage the children to use this witnessing tool with a friend who needs to know about Jesus.

QUIET TIME NOTEBOOK: (2 minute)

Highlight what was learned from last week's Quiet Time. Ask the children to do one per day before the next club. Remind them that they must show you their Q.T. Notebook next week to earn points for the contest.

MISSIONARY TIME: (15 minutes)

- 1. Sing "God's Way" while child comes to look in the "Go and Tell" Box.
- 2. Share missionary information for Week #3 using the "Go and Tell" Box. (See attached page.)
- 3. Pray for the missionary.
- 4. Show goal chart and mention the amount given so far.
- 5. Missions song:
- 6. Story: "Ly Huy's Escape." Teach the portion of the story listed under Week #3.

REVIEW ACTIVITY: (5 minutes)

Use the Review Activity below <u>or</u> the Bible Learning Game from the "Involvement Helps for Younger Children."

Review questions for JOSEPH #4:

- 1. The king's butler, to whom Joseph showed kindness in prison, forgot Joseph for two years. What happened to make him remember? (Pharaoh had some dreams and no one else could tell him what they meant.)
- 2. What were Pharaoh's dreams? (Seven fat cows came out of the river and seven skinny cows came out and ate up the fat cows. Seven good heads of grain grew on one stalk and seven poor heads of grain grew after them and ate them up.)
- 3. What did Joseph say when Pharaoh said, "I have heard that you can tell the meaning of dreams?" ("I cannot tell what dreams mean, but God can give the meaning.")
- 4. What did Joseph tell him the dreams meant? (God was saying there would be seven years of plenty of food and seven years of no food, or famine, in Egypt.)
- 5. Joseph gave Pharaoh some advice. What was it? (Pharaoh should look for a man to be in charge of storing up food during the seven years of much food so there would be food to live during the seven years of famine to keep the Egyptians from starving.)
- 6. What surprise did Joseph have one day when he was selling food during the famine? (He saw ten of his brothers come to buy food.)
- 7. Why were the brothers afraid when Joseph said they were spies? (The punishment for spies was death.)
- 8. Why did the brothers think this was happening to them? (They had guilty consciences because of what they did to Joseph and thought this was punishment for what they had done.)
- 9. What did Joseph demand to prove that they were not spies? (That they bring their younger brother to Egypt.)
- 10. What kind thing did Joseph do for his brothers before they left Egypt? (He had the money they paid for the food returned to their grain sacks.)








INTRODUCE THE VERSE:

Hold up a trophy, medal, certificate, or other award and ask the children to tell you what it is. Then explain that a reward is something earned when one completes a task successfully (whether it be running a race, receiving the highest grade on a test, sitting quietly in class, bringing the most visitors, etc.). In our verse today, we're going to learn about special rewards that God gives.

READ THE VERSE:

Read the verse together from the visualized verse. Then read the verse directly from the Bible.

EXPLAIN THE VERSE:

Remember our verse from last week? (*Place visual on the board. Have children say it together then ask them to tell you what it means.*) Our verse today (*show flashcard*) is the very next verse in the Bible. It tells us why we should do all things heartily and for the Lord.

Colossians 3:24

This is where the verse is found in the Bible. We call it the address or reference. It is found in the book of Colossians, chapter 3, verse 24.

"Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward"

Some rewards you receive right away. But God will reward us in Heaven one day for all that we've done that pleased Him.

"...for ye serve the Lord Christ"

Those of us who know Jesus as our Saviour are to serve Him. We do that by living in a way that pleases Him. When we work for Him, He will reward us.

(Saved) Those of us who know Jesus as Saviour can look forward to receiving rewards from Him for doing our chores heartily or happily for Him.

(Unsaved) This promise is only for those who have trusted Jesus as their Saviour. If you have never done that, I would be happy to show you how.

REPEAT THE VERSE:

"Crazy Stand-Ups" - After you have read this verse from the Bible, explained what it means, and repeated it at least two times, you may begin this drill. Have all the children wearing red stand and repeat the verse; all the children who ride the bus to school stand and repeat the verse; those who have a pet; those who like chocolate ice cream; those who have one brother or sister; those who have brown eyes; etc.

MEMORY VERSE: Shortened verse

Colossians 3:24 - "... For ye serve the Lord Christ."

Colossians 3:24	– Hands as an open Bible.

BIBLE LESSON HELPS:

Scene 1	- Put both palms at very top of forehead, fingers pointing up to look like Pharaoh's headgear, as you say, "Go and bring that man here."
Scene 2	 Pick food while slowly counting to 7. Then search for food while slowly counting to 7. Hold out hand as if a ring is being put on your finger. Pretend to be putting on a robe of importance.
Scene 3	- As his brothers, bow down before Joseph.
Scene 4	 Spread fingers in front of face to indicate brothers looking out through prison bars. Count out aloud to 3. Let the brothers out of jail by bringing hands down.
Scene 5	- Have children stand, look at one another, and say, "We are guilty. That's why this trouble has come."

BIBLE LEARNING GAME: "Food in Egypt"

Have children form a line across one side of the room (in Canaan). Choose a "Joseph" to stand on other side of room with his back to the others. Children (as going to Egypt), walk slowly toward "Joseph," asking "*May we buy food?*"

"Joseph" answers, "No! You are spies." Children keep moving ahead until "Joseph" answers "Yes." At that moment, he turns and chases them back to the starting line (Canaan). If someone is tagged, that person becomes the next "Joseph." If not, you choose another. After each turn, say, "Joseph served God, and God rewarded Joseph. The Lord will reward you, too, as you choose to serve Him."

Play as time allows.

GO AND TELL BOX Week #3 – What Does a Missionary Do?

(Suggested item to put in the "Go and Tell" Box – a paint brush.)

What do you think a paint brush has to do with *going and telling*? *(Let the children share their ideas.)*

You may think that missionaries are like preachers. Well, in some ways they are. However, missionaries do much more than just teach the Bible, God's Word, to others.



WHAT DOES A MISSIONARY DO? (Use WHAT wordstrip.)

There are many kinds of work that God calls missionaries to do. Some are teachers, preachers, nurses, doctors, artists, builders, writers, and translators. Whatever kind of work a missionary does, it is always to help others learn about Jesus.

How can a nurse help others learn about Jesus? While she is taking care of someone who is sick, she can tell that person about Jesus. How can a translator help others learn about Jesus? He is putting the Bible and other books in the language of the people so they can study about Jesus. A builder can build a church where people can come to hear about Jesus.

WHAT DO OUR MISSIONARIES DO?

TEACH CHILDREN – (Use TEACH CHILDREN wordstrip.) Some are teaching children about the Lord Jesus in Good News Clubs, Released Time Classes, Sunday Schools, Vacation Bible Schools, camps, and special meetings.


TRAIN TEACHERS – (Use TRAIN TEACHERS wordstrip.) Many people in other countries can help the missionaries tell the children about Jesus if they have some training. Our missionaries hold special training classes so adults can learn how to teach children. In the classes, they learn how to tell a Bible lesson, how to teach a memory verse, and how to explain God's simple way of salvation.

PREPARE VISUALS – (Use PREPARE VISUALS wordstrip.) There are always many visual aids such as flannelgraph/flashcard lessons and songs to be made, colored, and/or cut out. Since many visuals cannot be bought in the language of the people, they have to be translated, typed, printed, and prepared for the teachers.

LET'S PRAY FOR OUR MISSIONARIES:

THANK God for those who have already been trained to help the missionaries.

PRAY that the Lord will give our missionaries the strength to do the many things that they need to do. Pray that many people will join in helping them.
