

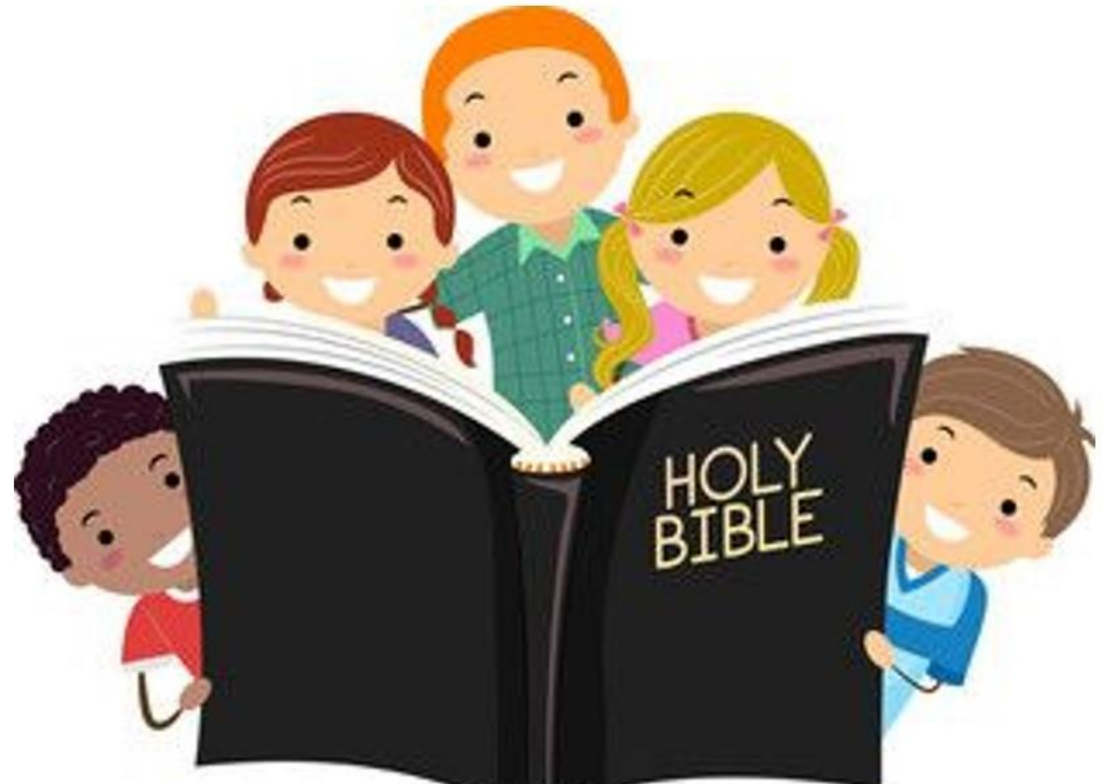
# Discovering Series – The Disciples JESUS Called

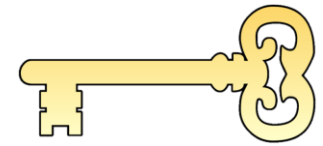
- God made me to have a special relationship with Him.

# PETER

“He (Jesus) said to **him** the third time, ‘Simon, son of John, do you love Me?’ **Peter**...said...

“Lord, You know everything; You know that I love You.” Jesus said to **him**, ‘Feed My sheep....’”

John 21:17

Before Jesus was put on the cross, **Peter** denied Jesus three times. When people asked if he was one of Jesus’ disciples, he said, “**I do not know Him.**”

Luke 22:57b

Amazingly, Jesus still loved **Peter**. He forgave **Peter**, and after He came back to life again, He used **Peter** to tell many people about how they could be saved from their sin.

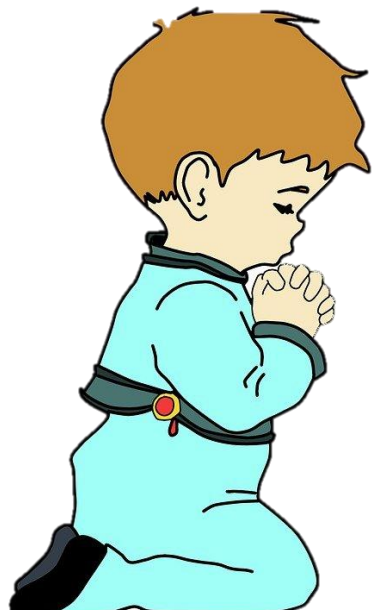
