# THE ARMOR OF GOD

## DAY - 1

A long time ago, when men would go into battle, they would wear big heavy armor.

Do you know why they would wear it?

- To keep warm
- To protect themselves from the enemy and his attacks
- To disguise themselves so the enemy wouldn't see them coming



God tells us in His Word, the Bible that those who know Jesus as their Savior need to put on armor too.

Why?

Because we also have an enemy! His name is Satan.

# THE ARMOR OF GOD

## DAY - 2

Where did Satan come from?

Satan was once a beautiful angel who served God in Heaven. **But Satan did not want to serve and worship God.** He wanted others to serve and worship him instead.



You [Satan] said in your heart, "I will ascend to the heavens... **I will make myself like the Most High**" (Isaiah 14:13-14).

Satan wanted to be greater than God.

» Many times you and I want the same thing. We want people to look at us and think about how good we are because **we are good at sports**, or **we are smart at math**, or **we wear nice clothes**. Instead of this, **we should want people to look at us and think about how good God is.**

## DAY - 3

### What is Satan like?

Have you ever seen a picture of Satan with a pitchfork and horns? Many people think that is what Satan looks like, **but that is not true**. In fact, the Bible tells us:

**"Satan disguises himself as**



**an angel of light"**

**(2 Cor. 11:14).**

He doesn't always look bad or scary. He makes himself look good!

We also know that **Satan is always trying to lie to you and me**. He loves to make sin look good. He wants you to believe that you will be happier **if you go your own way instead of listening to and obeying God**. The Bible says this:

**"...He is a liar and the father of lies"**



**(John 8:44).**

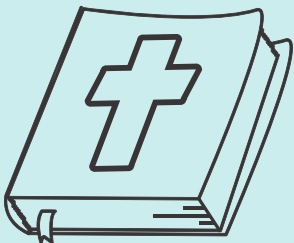
